

## Chicago Burlington & Quincy Railroad (CB&Q) 4–8–4 Steam Locomotive #5633

This massive steam locomotive was donated to the people of the State of Wyoming by the Chicago Burlington and Quincy Railroad Company. It was moved dead-intrain from Galesburg, Ill., to Orin, then via C&NW Railroad to Douglas in April 1962. Title was transferred to the City of Doualas in 1993.

The locomotive was built in the CB&Q shops at West Burlington, lowa, in September 1940 as one of the last class of steam locomotives on the Burlington. It was part of



an order for 28 317-ton units that were identical when built and were assigned Class 05-A. They were designed for fast freight and heavy passenger service. Baldwin Locomotive Works supplied the boiler and General Steel Casting of Chicago supplied the one-piece engine beds (frames). The locomotive has roller bearings and Baker Valve Gear.

The locomotive saw service system wide on CB&Q but evidence indicates #5633 was not operated on the Colorado & Southern through Douglas. It was in service until 1956, then stored at Lincoln, Neb.
